

2009 CHEERLEADING INFORMATION

Our first practice will be August 4th, 2009 at Fireman's Park Keinle Field. 5 and 6 year olds will practice from 6:00 – 7:30 and 7 year old and up will practice from 6:00 – 8:00.

Practices will be on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday for the month of August. Gym schedules will be available as soon as we get confirmation from the school district.

All cheerleaders should wear sweats or shorts and sneakers. Hair should be pulled back in a pony tail and no jewelry of any kind can be worn. Please remove earrings from girl's ears prior to practice. Coordinators cannot be responsible for any jewelry.

Bathrooms are for emergency purposes only. Please remember to have your child use the bathroom before each practice.

Please arrive at practice on time and bring your child to their age group. At that point, all parents need to leave the field. No parent will be allowed onto the field during practice. There are places outside the fence where you are welcome to watch from.

If you have a football player on the league, please pick your cheerleader up from practice first. It gets dark on the field and we need to end the practice and empty the field by 8:00.

Cheerleading camp will be August 17th – 19th. Ages 6 – 9 will be from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm and ages 10 – 13 will be from 2:00 – 6:00 pm. These times are tentative depending on how many girls attend. The fee is \$60, which includes three days of instruction and a t-shirt. Permission slips will be available at cheerleading registration. There is no practice on the days that cheering camp is held. Cheerleading camp is strongly recommended for everyone on the league!

While attendance policy in the summer is somewhat flexible, if your child is not at the majority of the August practices, they may not be able to compete.

Games will begin in September. All cheerleaders are expected to attend all games. A game schedule will be distributed as soon as we receive it.

A handbook with all of the league rules will be distributed at registration. Please be sure to read through it so that there is no misunderstanding later in the season. Pay particularly close attention to the attendance policy. It is strictly enforced.
